You will begin by signing in at the front office between 6:45-7:00 a.m. and receive your daily schedule. A picture will also be taken of you and your student(s) to put on our Watch DOGS wall.

Tasks you may be asked to help with include:

- Making deliveries to classrooms
- Front office tasks
- Car rider duty (a.m. and p.m.)
- Lunch/Recess assistance
- Checking perimeter doors to ensure they are shut and locked
- Sweeping the hallways for students wondering around
- Reading a short book to classes
- Working with a small group of students on sight words or a short activity
- Prepping activities or teachers
- Assisting in specials PE, music, art


